

Ancient Right of Challenge

He who feels that he is untruly placed in a position not worthy of his true skill and metal may at any time challenge one who occupies a higher-ranked position.

The challenger must make his intention known by extending his racquet toward his chosen opponent and declaring in a voice loud enough for all to hear
“Ancient Right of Challenge.”

The challenged has no right of refusal.

If the challenger wins, then he will successfully occupy his opponent's original position.

The defeated individual may reclaim his position in a subsequent challenge, but must wait a period of twenty-four hours.
